On January 20, 1999, the North Dakota Securities Commissioner issued a Cease and Desist Order, Notice of Civil Penalty, and Notice of Right to Request a Hearing, in the matter of New World International, "a citizen's group", Charles E. Thompson, and their Officers, Directors, Agents and Employees.

On March 5, 1999, the above-referenced Cease and Desist Orders were consolidated for the purposes of administrative process, and a hearing on the matter was set for May 6, 1999.

On May 6, 1999, each of the respondents failed to appear, either in person or through representation, at the hearing, which had been set in the above-referenced matters.

§28-32-08.4(1) N.D.C.C. provides that an agency may find a party in default if that party fails to attend a hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, The North Dakota Securities Commissioner hereby Orders that **BERT BJUR, NEW WORLD INTERNATIONAL, "A CITIZEN'S GROUP", CHARLES E. THOMPSON, AND THEIR OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, AGENTS AND EMPLOYEES** are in default, and that the Commissioner's Cease and Desist Orders set forth above are final orders. The North Dakota Securities Commissioner also hereby notifies each of the respondents that they are in default in the above-referenced matter and that the Cease and Desist Orders discussed above are final.

If you wish to contest this order, you may do so as permitted by §28-32-08.4(2) N.D.C.C.
