WHEREAS, on March 23, 1999, the Cease and Desist Order was sent to First Fidelity Financial Corporation and the Cease and Desist Order was received by First Fidelity Financial Corporation on March 26, 1999; and,

WHEREAS, respondent did not provide a request for hearing, nor did respondent deny any facts relied upon by the Commissioner underlying the Cease and Desist Order dated March 22, 1999.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby Ordered that respondent, First Fidelity Financial Corporation is hereby assessed and shall make payment to the Commissioner, a civil penalty in the amount of \$20,000 for the violations set forth above and in the Cease and Desist Order dated March 22, 1999. The payment of the civil penalties are due and payable immediately upon receipt of this Order.
