



and Desist Order. The Respondent had been provided notice in the Cease and Desist Order that the violations described above were sufficient grounds for assessing civil penalties.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED**, that the Respondent, Gurpal S. Shokar, is assessed a civil penalty of \$10,000 for his involvement in the violations set forth above. Payment of that civil penalty is due immediately and should be sent to the Office of the Securities Commissioner.

#### NOTICE OF RIGHT TO REQUEST HEARING

**YOU ARE NOTIFIED** that pursuant to N.D.C.C. §10-04-16 you may request a hearing before the Securities Commissioner if such a request is made in writing WITHIN TEN (10) DAYS AFTER THE RECEIPT OF THIS ORDER. The Respondents have the right to be represented by legal counsel at the hearing.
