The North Dakota Securities Commissioner has advised the Respondent, James Newton Darwin, II, that he is prepared to commence formal action pursuant to NDCC Chapter 10-04 and has determined as follows:

- On June 17, 1999, the North Dakota Securities Commissioner issued a
 Proposed Order to Revoke the Salesman Registration of James Newton
 Darwin, II, Summary Suspension of the Salesman Registration of James
 Newton Darwin, II, Notice of Civil Penalty and Notice of Right to Request a
 Hearing against James Newton Darwin, II.
- On June 23, 1999, the Commissioner received a request for hearing on behalf of James Newton Darwin, II. On June 25, 1999, the Commissioner issued a Notice of Hearing, wherein the Commissioner set the hearing on this matter for Tuesday, July 6, 1999.
- 3. Mr. Darwin has acknowledged the truthfulness of the Commissioner's allegations as set forth in the Proposed Order to Revoke the Salesman Registration of James Newton Darwin, II, Summary Suspension of the

Salesman Registration of James Newton Darwin, II, Notice of Civil Penalty and Notice of Right to Request a Hearing dated June 17, 1999.

- 4. Respondent has further explained his actions by stating that he was relying on the advice of his attorney when, through the course of his application for registration as a securities salesman in North Dakota, he decided not to inform the Commissioner that he was terminated from his employment with Commercial Union Life Insurance because he submitted fraudulent annuity applications to Commercial Union Life Insurance for the purpose of earning unjustified commissions.
- 5. The facts set forth above and in the Commissioner's Proposed Order to Revoke the Salesman Registration of James Newton Darwin, II, Summary Suspension of the Salesman Registration of James Newton Darwin, II, Notice of Civil Penalty and Notice of Right to Request a Hearing dated June 17, 1999 demonstrate that Mr. Darwin engaged in an apparent violation of §10-04-15 N.D.C.C., which constitutes sufficient grounds for the Commissioner to assess civil penalties in an amount not to exceed \$10,000 pursuant to §10-04-16(1) N.D.C.C. and to revoke the salesman registration of James Newton Darwin, II as a securities salesman in North Dakota pursuant to §10-04-11(1) N.D.C.C.

The following Order is necessary and appropriate in the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, THAT:

- Respondent, James Newton Darwin, II, shall not transact any securities business with any person in North Dakota unless the securities are offered through an organization which is registered as a dealer or properly exempted under NDCC Chapter 10-04.
- Respondent, James Newton Darwin, II, shall not act as a securities salesman for any securities business with any person in North Dakota unless he is registered as a salesman or properly exempted under NDCC Chapter 10-04.
- Respondent, James Newton Darwin, II, shall pay a civil penalty of \$3,000 to the Office of the Securities Commissioner pursuant to §10-04-16 N.D.C.C.
 Such civil penalty shall be paid immediately upon execution of this Consent Order
- 4. Respondent, James Newton Darwin, II, shall, contemporaneously with the execution of this Consent Order, be permitted to withdraw his salesman registration in North Dakota.
- 5. The Commissioner's Proposed Order to Revoke the Salesman Registration of James Newton Darwin, II, Summary Suspension of the Salesman Registration of James Newton Darwin, II, Notice of Civil Penalty

and Notice of Right to Request a Hearing dated June 17, 1999 is hereby revoked.

6. This Order shall be effective upon signature of the Commissioner.
